

2018 HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL PROCEDURES

- 1. High School Summer School will take place at Martinsburg High School for <u>Berkeley</u> County students only.
- 2. Summer School will begin **June 14** and will end **July 27**; hours will be 7:30am 12:45pm.
- 3. The attendance and discipline policies will be defined in the Summer School Handbook.
- 4. Students will register at their home schools by June 1.
- 5. The home school will accept the application and the tuition (check written to the <u>home school</u>, money order or cash). The school will photocopy the check or money order and attach it to the application. Summer School tuition for a ½ credit is \$250. Free lunch students will pay half that price (\$125) and reduced lunch students will pay full price.
- 6. All money collected at the school will be deposited in the school's account with one school check being forwarded to Linda Clarke, Department of Instruction, by June 7.
- 7. Applications will be picked up by the Summer School principal on June 4.
- 8. No meals will be served during Summer School, but students may purchase snacks from the vending machines or may bring snacks from home to eat during breaks.
- 9. Bus transportation will be provided to and from the following schools:

- 10. Classes will be held contingent upon sufficient enrollment. If the student is not notified, registration has been accepted and the student should report on the first day of class. A minimum of 12 students is required to hold the class.
- 11. For the purpose of gaining athletic eligibility, students may not repeat transcripted courses for which they have already received credit.
- 12. Courses taken with the Pass/Fail option, such as Grad Point courses, cannot be used to make a student eligible for athletics or the Promise Scholarship.

The Berkeley County School system will offer a 2018 high school summer program with the following guidelines:

- 1. There will be two terms. The first term begins June 14 and ends July 6; the second term begins July 9 and ends July 27. The hours for both terms will be 7:30 a.m. -12:45 p.m.
- 2. A student will earn 1/2 credit for each term attended. First semester classes may only be taken during first term; second semester classes may only be taken second term.
- 3. Students who miss more than 2 days per semester regardless of the reason will receive a failing grade for the semester. Please see Student Handbook.
- 4. The program will be located at Martinsburg High School. Driver's Education students will report to Martinsburg High School the first day.
- 5. The tuition will be \$250 per 1/2 credit for Berkeley County students. Students on free lunch will pay half that price (\$125) and reduced lunch students will pay full price.
 Only Berkeley County students will be accepted. PLEASE MAKE PAYMENT to
 STUDENT'S HOME SCHOOL. After June 1, please make payment to Berkeley County Schools and deliver or mail form to Rachel Stein, Martinsburg High School, 701 South Queen Street, Martinsburg, WV 25401.
- 6. Refunds will be honored upon request from students attending 3 or fewer days of class. All refund requests must be made prior to the end of Summer School. Requests must be made in person to the Summer School principal.
- 7. No student will be admitted to Summer School after June 18, 2018, for 1st term or July 11, 2018, for 2nd term.
- 8. No meals will be served during Summer School, but students may purchase snacks from the vending machines or may bring snacks from home to eat during breaks.
- 9. Bus transportation will be provided to and from the following schools:
