Roger Moss Memorial Scholarship Beatrice Noll Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

1. Applicants must be children of current and/or retired members of the Berkeley County Education Association.
2. The recipient shall be a graduating senior of an accredited high school or a student currently enrolled in undergraduate school. No student may receive the award more than once in his/her college career.
3. This award may be used at any college, trade, or technical school.
4. This award shall be a non-renewable \$500 scholarship.
5. This award shall be payable to the student selected upon notification to the president of the Berkeley County Education Association (BCEA) of acceptance to and enrollment in the institution of higher education. Repayment of these funds is required if the student withdraws from school during the first semester.
6. Applications for this award are available from the high school guidance counselors and are due by April 1 to the BCEA president.
7. The criteria for selection of the winner shall be academic achievement (minimum 3.0), participation in school and community activities, and good personal character.
8. The application is due April 1.
