- I. Eligibility: The Johnson Williams High School/Raymond Ratcliff Scholarship is open to any graduating high school senior who:
 - a. Is a Relative of someone who attended Johnson Williams High School, Josephine City School, WTB, Clarke County Training School, Boyce, White Post, Millwood School or Webbtown Schools.
 - b. Possesses a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.70
 - c. Plans on attending a two or four year college or technical school

II. Official Transcript

Please provide an official transcript, certified by your high school counselor or principal. Make sure it indicates your most current GPA and class ranking

III. Recommendation Form

Please provide two recommendations from a Teacher or Counselor and a Community Member. (Should not come from friends or family member)

IV. Essay

Essay of at least 200 words describing two goals and how this scholarship will assist you in attaining these goals. Also, describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability in school, work and or /or community and how these experiences prepared you to become a leader at your intended college/training school and beyond.

V. Deadline

All application packets must be **postmarked by Friday April 13, 2019**. Applicants must submit completed application packets. Incomplete packets will **NOT** be reviewed and will therefore be eliminated from the selection process.
