## **Colleen Miller Memorial Education Fund Scholarship**

Colleen Miller was a well-known, highly respected and dearly loved educator in Berkeley County for over 30 years. These scholarships are being awarded to Berkeley County Schools' graduates who exemplify Colleen's passion as a leader, a role model, an educator and an advocate for children.

#### AWARD:

The Colleen Miller Memorial Education Fund will award up to five \$1000.00 scholarships to graduating seniors from Berkeley County High Schools pursuing a BA degree in Education from an accredited university or college in West Virginia. The scholarships will be awarded based on the following factors: character references, demonstrated volunteerism and community service, academic performance, and financial need.

Payment will be made directly to the university or college each semester.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- > There will be no discrimination on the basis of race, national origin, religion, sexual orientation or gender.
- Must be a resident of Berkeley County and a student of Berkeley County Schools.
- Must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Must enroll full-time at an accredited university or college in West Virginia.
- Must provide two sealed letters of reference, one of which is from a teacher or guidance counselor. Cannot be a member of your family.
- Must document history of community service and volunteerism.
- Must demonstrate financial need.

#### RENEWAL:

- > The scholarships are renewable annually for up to three additional consecutive years.
- > Renewal applicants must provide proof of full-time enrollment, maintenance of a minimum 3.0 GPA, and current financial status.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS:**

The attached application must be completed and submitted to the high school guidance office by March 1st

Applications will be reviewed by members of the Colleen Miller Memorial Fund committee. Winners will be notified of their scholarship award no later than April 15th. Personal interviews may be requested. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
