#### **Timeline & Process**

- 1. EWVCF releases the scholarship application in October.
- 2. Students complete application, filling out all required fields and attaching all required documentation. October - February
- 3. Completed application packages are delivered to our offices or postmarked on or before February 28th.
- 4. All COMPLETED scholarship applications undergo a review process with volunteer committees making award selections. Interviews are conducted for certain scholarships. March-April
- 5. EWVCF Board of Directors makes final approval of scholarship awards. May
- 6. Applicants will be notified in early May, *only if selected* to receive a scholarship award. (Notification will come by way of an invitation to our 2019 Scholarship Awards Reception)
- 7. If awarded, students will be given a scholarship acceptance form that must be completed and returned to the EWVCF office by June 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 8. Scholarship awards will be mailed to the colleges in July. (Scholarships are paid directly to a student's educational institution on his or her behalf, for-profit institutions are prohibited)
