BACKGROUND:

The James A. Tolbert, Sr. Rights Scholarship was established in 2006 by Attorney and Mrs. J. Franklin Long in honor of Mr. Tolbert of Charles Town, WV. He served as president of the West Virginia State Conference of NAACP Branches from 1986 to 2007.

AWARD:

One scholarship of \$1000 will be awarded to a student graduating from an accredited high school in West Virginia at the end of the 2018-2019 school year.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Enter a four-year college/university as a full-time freshman in the Fall of 2019;
- Have a scholastic average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 SCALE;
- Demonstrate a financial need;
- Not related to the Tolbert family.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- Submit a neat application with all areas completed;
- Have a letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator;
- Have a letter of recommendation from an individual familiar with your community service activities;
- Submit a copy of your transcript with an official school seal and SAT or ACT scores;
- Include a statement by someone who knows of your financial need;
- Will not accept references from relatives;
- SUBMIT A TYPED, DOUBLE SPACED ESSAY OF NO MORE THAN TWO PAGES ON THE TOPIC "HOW THE NAACP HAS INFLUENCED MY LIFE AND MAY IMPACT MY FUTURE".

The completed applications, letters and transcripts must be postmarked by or before May 11, 2019. Late applications will not be considered. All information is confidential. The 2019 recipient will not receive the scholarship award directly. When proof of enrollment is provided to the Tolbert Committee, the funds will be sent to the institution and credited to the student's account.
