After raising her four young children she later returned to school attending Shepherd for her B.S. and WVU for her M.S. to work as Social Worker and Special Education Teacher.

Applicants: Senior Students at Martinsburg or East Hardy High Schools that have a disability. They can be students that plan to attend a college, trade school, or an adult program.

Applicants must create a short 1-page essay that gives information on their disability including how it has affected their lives and what they would like to pursue to further their Education.

Deadline to Apply: April 20.
