

Appropriate Dress for Photographs, Awards & Graduation

- *Graduation cap & gown
- *Dress (1-2 inches above gown hemline and does not show in V portion of the gown)
- *Black or dark dress shoes (no flip flops)

or

- *White shirt with dark tie
- *Dark slacks (preferably black)
- *Dark dress shoes & socks (preferably BLACK)

Press your gown before picture day & graduation. Do not use steam. Make sure your name is on all your garments, especially your cap.

The high school graduation cap is worn flat on the head, one point of the square facing forward (like a diamond)

Tassels are worn on the right side at the start of the graduation ceremony, and you flip it to the left when graduates receive their diplomas.

No person will be admitted to graduation without a ticket IF ceremony is held inside

Graduation @ 7:00 p.m. at Martinsburg High School

Report to MHS large gym for line-up in cap and gown and appropriate dress.

No one is allowed in the gym with the exception of graduates.

You **MUST** be in line **by 6:00 p.m**. in order to participate in the ceremony. After a successful ceremony, your official diploma will be given to you by MHS Staff at the south end zone at band bleachers.

Graduation is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Cobourn Field on May 22nd. There is no limit to the number of guests who may attend at Cobourn Field. To ensure enough mobility/physical disability seats are available to those in need, there will be an orange ticket issued.

In case of inclement weather, the graduation ceremony will be held at Martinsburg High's Gymnasium and guests will be admitted by white inclement weather tickets only. On May 18th, during graduation practice, seniors will receive 4 white inclement weather tickets to graduation, as well as mobility or physical disability tickets that were previously requested.

- 1.) Shorts, boots, sandals, sneakers and flip flops are not considered appropriate. Students wearing improper attire will **NOT** be permitted to walk in the ceremony.
- 2.) Please conduct yourself with dignity during the ceremony. All eyes are on you. This ceremony may be one of the most memorable in your life, please do not ruin it for yourself, your family, or your classmates by being rude.
